

WHAT IS A PGWP?

A PGWP IS...

- An open work permit
- Allows you to gain Canadian work experience after graduation (e.g., full-time, part-time, self-employment)
- Possible occupational restrictions (e.g. health care, primary/secondary school, childcare)
- Can only be issued once per lifetime



DIVISION OF CONTINUING STUDIES (DCS) DEFINITIONS & PGWP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL PGWP ELIGIBILITY

- ☐ Complete an eligible program in Canada that's at least 8 months in length
- ☐ Continuous full-time enrolment in all regular academic terms except for authorized Leave of Absence or final term
- ☐ As of September 1, 2024, you must complete at least 50% of your program in class inside Canada
- As of November 1, 2024, you must provide <u>proof of language ability</u> to meet the language requirements for the PGWP when you submit your application.
- ☐ If you submitted your study permit application to IRCC before November 1, 2024, you do not need to meet the field of study requirement.

FULL-TIME DEFINITION AT DCS

Full-time Definitions at DCS

• 3 courses per term, of at least 36 hours per course

Regular Academic Terms

- Fall Term (September to December)
- Winter Term (January April)
- Summer Term (May to August) (if first study term)

Summer Regularly Scheduled Breaks

 May – August (The break does not apply if the summer term is your first or last study term)

POST-GRADUATION WORK PERMIT VALIDITY

A PGWP can be granted for a minimum of 8 months to a maximum of 3 years.

- 8 months to < 2 years = the length of the program completed</p>
- 2 years or longer = 3 years

COVID-19 SPECIAL MEASURES

TEMPORARY POLICY – DISTANCE LEARNING

- Distance Learning from outside Canada
 - You can complete up to 100% of your studies online from outside Canada between March 2020 and August 31, 2022, because of a temporary COVID-19 policy.
- Distance Learning from inside Canada
 - If your courses were moved online due to the pandemic, the time you spend studying online from within Canada until August 31, 2024, still counts toward the length of your PGWP.

TEMPORARY POLICY: DISTANCE LEARNING

All students who started a program of study between September 1, 2022, and August 31, 2024, are required to complete at least 50% of their program of study in Canada (online or in class).

• For the above group of students, up until **August 31, 2024**, time spent studying **outside of Canada** can be counted toward the overall length of the PGWP only if it constitutes less than 50% of the program.

*Any time a student spend studying outside of Canada **after** August 31, 2024, and any time spent studying outside Canada before applying for a study permit, will be deducted from the length of the PGWP, regardless of when the student started or will start their program of study.*

APPLYING FOR PGWP

HOW TO APPLY FOR A PGWP

- Apply online
 - As of June 21, 2024, you can no longer apply for a PGWP at a port of entry (POE).
- You must apply within 180 days after you receive your final grade
- In Canada: Apply within 90
 days after you receive your final
 grade AND while your study is valid

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- □ Application form <u>IMM5710</u> (inside Canada) or <u>IMM 1295</u> (outside Canada)
- Program completion letter
- Official transcript or administrative transcript from <u>DCS My Account</u> with final grades
- Valid passport
- Digital photo

- Credit or debit card to pay your fees online
- Proof of meeting minimum levels of language ability (CLB 7)
- Medical exam (if applicable)
- Biometrics (if applicable)

PGWP APPLICATION TIPS

- Apply for graduation in your final term.
- You can request your program completion letter and final transcript when your final grades are available in your <u>DCS My Account</u>.
- Only submit your PGWP application when you receive UVic documents (program completion letter AND final transcript).
- Make sure you book an <u>approved language test</u> (IELTS general) well in advance.
- Online applications are saved in your IRCC secure account for up to 60 days only.

PGWP APPLICATION TIPS

- Keep paper or electronic copies of your application form and supporting documents.
- Take screenshots at different stages and monitor your application status online.
- Apply as soon as you collect all the required documents.
- Use the <u>IRCC Web Form</u> to update IRCC or follow up on application status.
- Consult our office before you submit the application if you have questions.

AFTER YOU APPLY

- Current processing time
- Working while your PGWP application is under process

You can work full time after you submit your application and until a decision is made if you:

- ☐ had a <u>valid study permit</u> at the time you submitted your application
- ☐ completed your study program
- were eligible to work off campus without a work permit while studying and you didn't work more hours than you were allowed to

*If you don't meet all the conditions above to work, you must stop working after you receive your final grade and wait until you receive your PGWP to start working.


A medical exam is needed before you submit your application for foreign nationals who:

- want to stay in Canada for more than 6 months and have lived in one or more <u>designated countries</u> or <u>territories</u> for more than six months in the past year or;
- · intend to work in one of the following jobs:
 - o health sciences worker
 - o clinical laboratory worker
 - o patient attendant in nursing or geriatric homes
 - o medical student admitted to Canada to attend university
 - o medical elective and physician on short term assignment
 - o teacher of primary or secondary schools or other teachers of small children
 - o domestics worker, someone who gives in-home care to children, the elderly and the disabled
 - o day nursery worker



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

- Can I travel outside Canada while I have a PGWP application being processed in Canada?
- When do I need to stop working, when my course(s) are complete or when I receive my final grades? (IRCC)
- Should I work up to a maximum of 24 hours per week while I wait for the final grades during the final academic term (not a break)? (IRCC)
- How can I prove to a potential employer that I am eligible to work while I await processing of my application? (IRCC)
- How long does it take to receive a program completion letter?
